Facing the font (or vessel) containing the water, the Archbishop says the following:

Praise to you, almighty God and Father, for you have created water to cleanse and to give life.

Assembly

Come to us, Lord, Father of all, and make holy this water which you have created, so that all who are baptised in it may be washed clean of sin and be born again to live as your children.

Assembly

Hear us, Lord.

Archbishop

Make this water holy, Lord, so that all who are baptised into Christ's death and resurrection, by this water may become more perfectly like your Son.

Assembly

Hear us, Lord.

The Archbishop touches the water with his right hand and continues:

Lord, make holy this water which you have created, so that all those whom you have chosen may be born again by the power of the Holy Spirit, and may take their place among your holy people.

The Candidates for Baptism will now be asked to renounce sin and profess their faith

Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?

Elect: I do.

Archbishop

God, the all-powerful Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has given us a new birth by water and the Holy Spirit, and forgiven all our sins.

May he also keep us faithful to our Lord Jesus Christ for ever and ever.

Elect: Amen.

RITE OF BAPTISM

The elect approach the baptismal font with their Godparents.

Archbishop pours water on the heads of the candidates three times as he says:

N. I baptise you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

CLOTHING WITH THE WHITE GARMENT

Archbishop

Dear brethren, you have become a new creation and have clothed yourselves in Christ.

Take this white garment and bring it unstained to the judgement seat of our Lord Jesus Christ so that you may have everlasting life.

PRESENTATION OF THE LIGHTED CANDLE

Archbishop

Godparents, please come forward and give the newly baptised the light of Christ.

To the newly baptised

You have been enlightened by Christ.
Walk always as children of the light
and keep the flame of faith alive in your heats.

may you go out to meet him
with all the saints in the heavenly kingdom.

CELEBRATION OF CONFIRMATION

Archbishop

My dear friends, in baptism God our Father gave the new birth of eternal life to his chosen daughters.
Let us pray to our Father that he will pour out the Holy Spirit to strengthen these newly baptised daughters with his gifts and anoint them to be more like Christ the Son of God

The newly baptised kneel

Archbishop (with outstretched hands)

All powerful God, Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, by water and the Holy Spirit you freed your daughters from sin and gave them new life.

Send your Holy Spirit upon them to be their Helper and Guide.

Give them the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of right judgment and courage, the spirit of knowledge and reverence.

Fill them with the spirit of wonder and awe in your presence.

We ask this through Christ our Lord.

Assembly

Amen.

Those who are to be confirmed approach the Archbishop accompanied by their Godparent who has his/her right hand on the right shoulder of their Godson/Goddaughter.

The Archbishop dips a cotton bud in the chrism and, with it, makes the sign of the cross on the forehead of the one to be confirmed, as he says:

N. be sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit.

The newly confirmed responds: Amen.

The Archbishop says: Peace be with you.

The newly confirmed responds: And with your spirit.

All sit as the Offertory hymn is sung and the altar is prepared for the Liturgy of the Eucharist.

Blessed are you, Lord God of all creation, for through your goodness we have received the wine we offer you: fruit of the vine and work of human hands, it will become our spiritual drink.

Assembly

Blessed be God for ever.

Archbishop

With humble spirit and contrite heart may we be accepted by you, O Lord, and may our sacrifice in your sight this day be pleasing to you, Lord God.

Archbishop (inaudibly)

Wash me, O Lord, from my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.

All stand

Archbishop (to the Assembly)

Pray, brethren, that my sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to God, the almighty Father.

The Assembly rise and reply:

May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands, for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.

TAKE THIS, ALL OF YOU, AND DRINK FROM IT, FOR THIS IS THE CHALICE OF MY BLOOD, THE BLOOD OF THE NEW AND ETERNAL COVENANT, WHICH WILL BE POURED OUT FOR YOU AND FOR MANY FOR THE FORGIVENESS OF SINS. DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME.

Therefore, as we celebrate the memorial of his Death and Resurrection, we offer you, Lord, the Bread of life and the Chalice of salvation, giving thanks that you have held us worthy to be in your presence and minister to you. Humbly we pray that, partaking of the Body and Blood of Christ, we may be gathered into one by the Holy Spirit.

Remember, Lord, your Church, spread throughout the world, and bring her to the fullness of charity, together with Francis our Pope, me, your unworthy servant, Bishop Joseph who assists me, Bishop Mario, Bishop elect Anton and all the clergy.

Remember also, Lord, those who through baptism and confirmation have been joined to your Church today. Grant that they may follow Christ your Son with willing and generous hearts.

Archbishop

These our brothers and sisters today received baptism and so they may call God their Father. Let us therefore, with them, pray at the Saviour's command for our salvation:
